- Why you like them.
- How long you've had them.
- The tank setup you have (ponds are okay too).
- What fish or tanks you hope to have in the future What's your dream fish? Your dream tank?
- What else? Is there something else you'd like to share?

Would you like to share? Here's how:

- 2. Include the following information:
 - a. Your first and last name
 - b. Your contact information
 - c. Are you a youth (under 18) or adult (18 or older)?
 - d. What do you want to share?
 - d.i. An aquarium? If so, what kind? (Community, species, planted, biotope, etc.)
 - d.ii. Fish? If so, what species?
- 3. We will contact you with information about uploading your photos and videos. If you can't take photos yourself, please let us know in your email/message.
 - a. These should be YOUR OWN pictures/videos, not from the internet or other sources.
 - b. Preferably, send several photos or short videos. The SAS will choose the best pictures to fit in the time allotted.

If you're nervous about speaking in front of a group, don't worry – we'll stand up with you and interview you if you prefer, rather than having you stand alone and speak (whichever you prefer).

Please send your information as soon as possible. We plan to allow 5 - 10 minutes per person; with that, we will have time for about a half dozen members to share. If we get more responses, we'll plan another share night in 2021.
